## Golf Course Care — We trust and expect that all Members and Guests will help keep Tumble Creek a pristine golf experience. Please follow the Guidelines below.

- Golf Carts should remain 30 yards away from greens and tees at all times and
  on the path only on all Par 3 holes. Stay out of the native, long grass areas and
  on the cart path as much as possible.
- Please pick up broken tees on the teeing area and replace knocked over tee markers to ensure proper alignment.
- Please rake all use and damage in the bunkers. Rake should be placed outside
  the bunker and in a manner that does not interfere with play.
- Please be aware that golf shots that land on the green leave a ball mark.
   Please carry a ball mark repair tool during your round and fix your mark and any others that may have been missed.
- Please use the bent grass sand/seed mix on the carts to fill divots in the fairways only. Sand should be used to completely fill the divot and then smoothed with your foot.
- Allow smaller groups and faster players to play through. If you are going to bypass another group of golfers, inform that group of your intentions before moving ahead of them.
- All golfers must check in with the Golf House before starting play.
- Please do your part and pick up any litter and place in the garbage cans.
   Water bottles, aluminum cans and other recycle materials should be placed in the recycling containers at the comfort stations.
- All golfers shall be in appropriate golf attire when using the golf course, practice green and driving range. Please wear a collared shirt and no denim. Shorts should be of khaki or bermuda style and appropriate length and hats worn in a conventional style. Women may wear skirts, skorts, and sleeveless shirts.
- Please use cell phones and other pda devices in a respectable manner when on the golf course. Please keep on silent at all times.
- Junior golfers and families will always be welcome on the golf course and driving range. Please ensure our juniors are dressed appropriately and learn the rules and etiquette of golf.
- Please take responsibility for your guests and assist them to understand the etiquette required at Tumble Creek Club. Thank you and have a great day on the course!!
